## Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) - Opt Out Form

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that Richland School District, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. However, Richland School District may disclose appropriately designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have advised the District to the contrary.

Directory information, which is information that is generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released, can also be disclosed to outside organizations without a parent's prior written consent. Two federal laws require local educational agencies (LEAs) receiving assistance under the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965* (ESEA) to provide military recruiters, upon request, with three directory information categories – names, addresses and telephone listings – unless parents have advised that they do not want their student's information disclosed without their prior written consent.

## Richland School District has designated the following information as directory information:

- -Student's name
- -Address/ Telephone listing
- -Yearbook
- -Grade level
- -Photograph/Video/News Media
- -Date and place of birth
- -Major field of study
- -Dates of attendance

- -Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- -Weight and height of members of athletic teams
- -Degrees, honors, and awards received
- -The most recent educational agency or institution attended
